- 3. Secretary (Sports) inquired about the event wise performance of Indian Sepaktakraw team as well as the milestones set for the Asian Games, 2022. Secretary General, Sepaktakraw Federation of India explained that 04 events (namely Regu, Team, Double and Quad) will be part of the Asian Games, 2022 for both Men & Women and their target is to achieve a total of 04 medals.
- 4. Secretary General, STFI informed that most of the players are from SSB and their training takes place at I.G, Stadium, Delhi and Assam but they do not have a proper training centre. Therefore, he requested for a permanent training centre at any of the SAI centres so that training can be conducted throughout the year.
- 5. Secretary (Sports) directed SAI to finalize a permanent training centre within a month and assured STFI that this centre along with hostel facilities will be developed within 06-07 month dedicated for Sepaktakraw discipline. Two Synthetic flooring are already procured and stationed at SAI, Aurangabad, which can be transferred as soon as the venue of training will be finalized.
- 6. Secretary General, STFI requested to commence regular NIS Diploma course once in two years since it has not been conducted from 2001 due to which the strength of coaches are not increasing. Secretary (Sports) was in agreement to commence the same from 2021-22.
- 7. Subject to above, total budget of **Rs. 1.68 Cr.** was approved for STFI up to March, 2021:
